What is a Conservative Citizen Journalist?

- *A Conservative Citizen Journalist (CCJ) is a concerned, capable Conservative who reports on newsworthy topics as a volunteer in partnership with a receptive news outlet.
 - ***** You Have the Power to Make News & Influence Opinion
 - ***** You Provide the Tips, Leads & Content...
 - ***We Provide the Credibility and Distribution**

*****Why Are Conservative Citizen Journalists Important?

- We do not have the resources to be everywhere, see everything and cover important issues – especially in your local area.
- Liberal outlets will ignore your tips, leads or submissions because it does not fit their narrative.



How to Become a Conservative Citizen Journalist in 6 Easy Steps



Step #1: What's Your Passion? Selecting a "Beat"

On a scale of 1 to 10, how interesting will this be to a conservative reading audience?

- This article has been checked for proper spelling, grammar and punctuation.
- Article is free of libelous, slanderous or false information.
- This article has all sources cited properly.
- This article has no plagiarized content.
- This article is free of the opinion of the writer. Opinions expressed are those of individuals referenced in the article or those interviewed for the article.
- This article has been checked against articles appearing elsewhere to ensure it is not duplicate content originated or syndicated on The Tennessee Conservative.
- This article has a descriptive, engaging, clickable headline.
- This article's content leads with the news aspect of the story and gets the attention of the reader in the first and second paragraphs.

By signing my name below, I agree to the above criteria for the article I am submitting. I understand that my article will not be published should the article not meet this criterion. I acknowledge that I am submitting this article as a Conservative Citizen Journalist and volunteer without promise of compensation or ownership of rights to work submitted. While submitting this article, I understand I am not an employee or contractor for The Tennessee Conservative. I give The Tennessee Conservative the rights and permission to publish this content without compensation, limitations, <u>copyrights</u> or caveats. I take full legal and financial responsibility for any false, <u>libelous</u> or slanderous content contained within the article I have submitted for publication.

Step #3: Review the "Checklist"

[This paragraph should provide more details, links to source documents, images, <u>video</u> or other items to back up the main thrust of the article. This paragraph will mainly be read by people who are really interested in the topic.]

[This closing paragraph should summarize the article and give readers a chance to get more information or <u>take action</u> if appropriate or relevant.]

About [Your Name]

[Boilerplate language about your background as a Conservative Citizen Journalists that readers would find relevant, <u>relatable</u> and engaging. Include a headshot image if you have one.]




