Castration

Castration is any action, surgical, chemical, or otherwise, by which an individual loses use of the testicles: the male gonad.

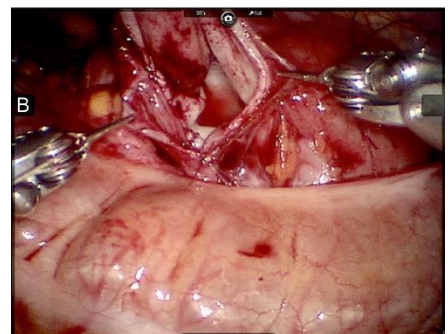
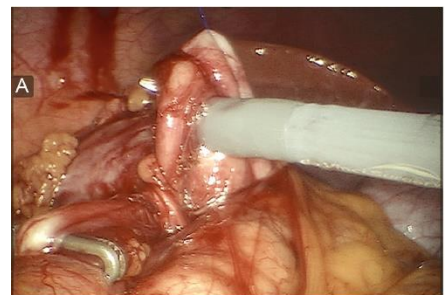
Metoidioplasty (informally called a meto or meta)

Is a female-to-male sex reassignment surgery. Testosterone replacement therapy gradually enlarges the clitoris to a mean maximum size of 4.6 cm.



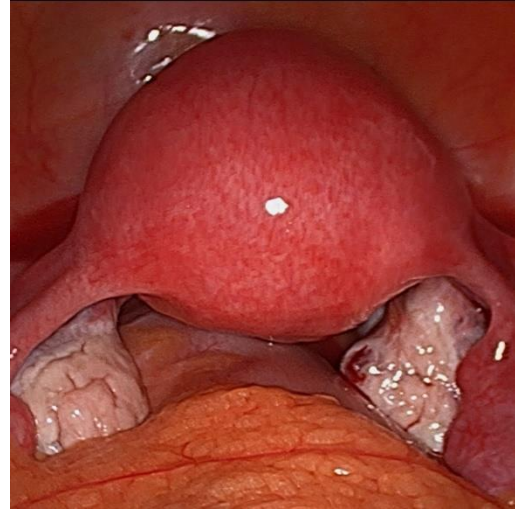
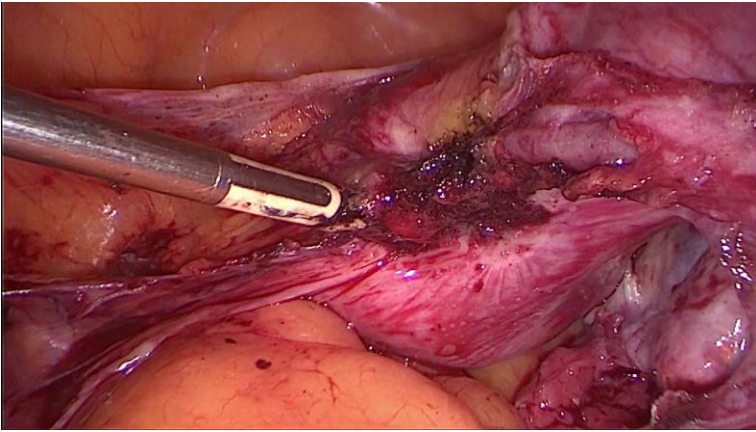
Vasectomy

Vasectomy is an elective surgical procedure for male sterilization or permanent contraception.



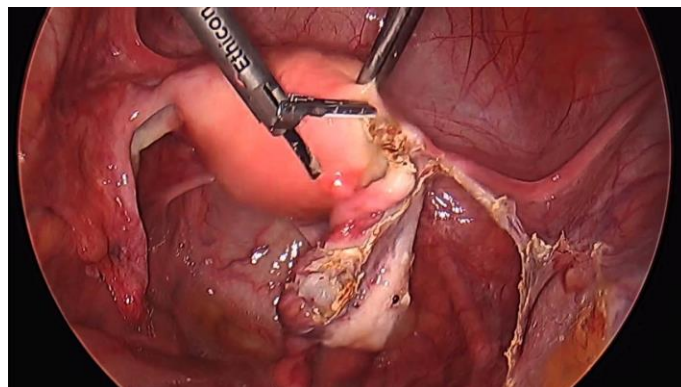
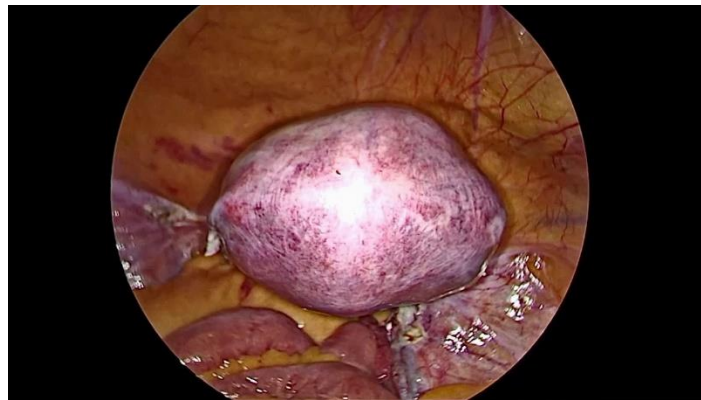
Hysterectomy

A surgical procedure to remove all or a part of the uterus.



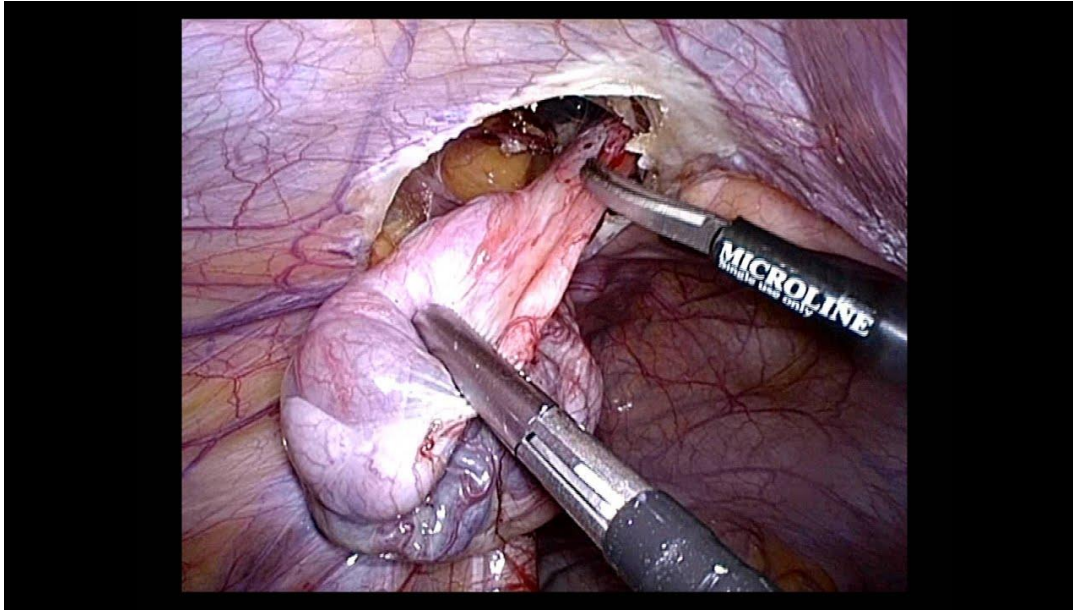
Oophorectomy

Surgical removal of ovaries which may cause infertility and menopause.



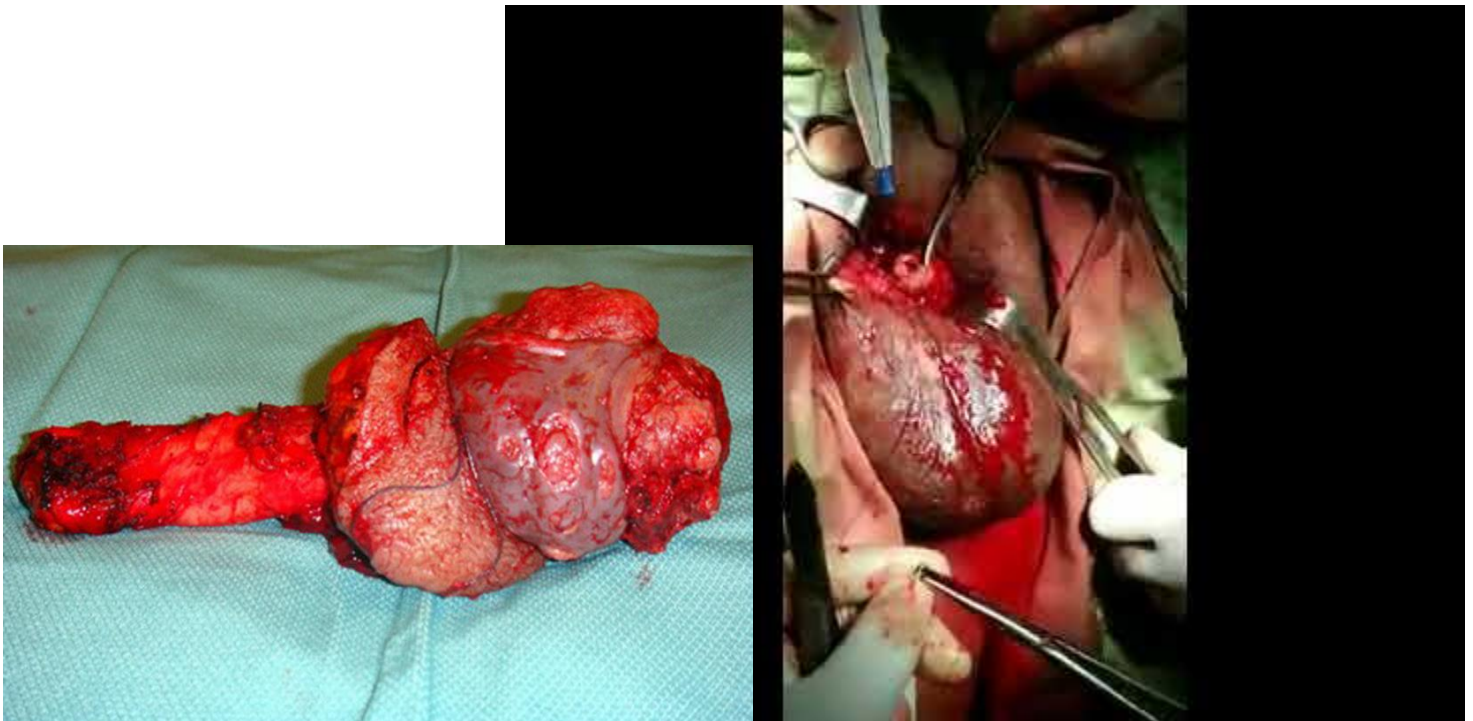
Orchiectomy

Surgical removal of one or both testicles for gender transition or to reduce the chances of spread of cancerous tumors.



Penectomy

Surgical amputation of the penis.



Phalloplasty

Phalloplasty is the construction or reconstruction of a penis or the artificial modification of the penis by surgery. The term is also occasionally used to refer to penis enlargement.



Vaginoplasty

Vaginoplasty is any surgical procedure that results in the construction or reconstruction of the vagina. It is a type of genitoplasty. Pelvic organ prolapse is often treated with one or more surgeries to repair the vagina.
