

EMPOWERED JEFFERSON COUNTY Faith-Family-Freedom

A RESOLUTION OBJECTING TO THE PASSAGE OF THE EDUCATION FREEDOM SCHOLARSHIP ACT

WHEREAS, Empowered Jefferson County, a Conservative Action Group, supports financially responsible school choice that does not impose controls on private schools with standardized testing procedures, and;

WHEREAS, The Education Freedom Scholarship Act, herein described as ("the act") is not a conservative bill and should not be enacted by the Tennessee General Assembly, and;

WHEREAS, the act dramatically expands government spending, imposes standardized testing procedures on private schools that receive state funding thus delegating rulemaking to unelected bureaucrats.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by a vote of the leadership of Empowered Jefferson County, meeting on this 27th day of January 2025, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee is urged to reject the passage of the Education Freedom Scholarship Act and to exclude home-schooled students from any future act of the same.

SECTION 2: That other Conservative Action Groups in the State of Tennessee are hereby urged to adopt this resolution in full or with similar language.
